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2019-2020 ILLINOIS RESIDENCY VERIFICATION

We anticipate that you may be eligible to receive an *Illinois Student Assistance Commission* (ISAC) Monetary Award Program Grant for the 2019-2020 academic year. Before we can determine if you are eligible for MAP funds, we must verify you or your parents' Illinois residency.

DEPENDENT STUDENT

Please submit a document from the list below that shows Illinois Residency for the parent who is required to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as of the FAFSA submission date.

For example, if your FAFSA was submitted on 10/5/18 you could submit a copy of your parent driver's license with a Date of Issue on or before 10/5/18 or a utility bill with the parent name and mailing address listed on it for the month of October 2018.

INDEPENDENT STUDENT

Please submit documentation from the list below that shows you have resided in Illinois for a minimum of twelve continuous, full months immediately prior to the start of the academic year.

To be an Illinois Resident for the 2019-2020 school year the period would be August 19, 2018 – August 18, 2019. For example, if your driver's license Date of Issue is on or before August 19, 2018 and Date of Expiration is after August 18, 2019, you could submit a copy of your driver's license.

Independent students may need to submit multiple items in order to cover the full 12-month period for example, nine months utility bills and 3 months' paycheck stubs.

- Illinois Driver's License
- State of Illinois Identification Card issued by the Secretary of State
- Utility or rent bills
- Illinois Auto Registration Card
- Residential lease
- Statement of benefits history from the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services
- Statement of benefits from the Illinois Department of Employment Security
- Statement of benefits from the Social Security Administration
- State of Illinois income tax return or federal tax transcript
- Wage and tax statements (IRS W-2 or 1099 forms)
- Illinois voter's registration card – must have a Date of Issue and Expiration
- Property tax bill
- Illinois High School or College transcript showing attendance for the 2018-2019 academic year
